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position would be willing to come here without being paid for it. I would hope they would and perhaps it should be that way, but on the other hand, I think maybe we at least owe them the mileage to come here each morning. I think we are invading a principle that has been established that has made America great and once we digress from this I think the problems we have before us today in our nation are going to become greater and greater. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. President. I, too, agree with Senator Chambers that it is not in good taste to have two representatives of the church entering into a race or bid for a position as Chaplain but that is as far as I will go. I will not support the rest of his statement. We are not imposing our views on Senator Chambers. The prayer is said before the Legislature goes into session and we are not forcing anyone to be in the Chamber at the time the prayer is said. I urge that we support Senator Lewis' motion to go on with approving the motion to accept the Chaplain that we had last year. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. Chairman, I have a question for Senator Lewis.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lewis, will you reply?

SENATOR HABERMAN: Senator Lewis, in regard to your poll, did you include the new legislators?

SENATOR LEWIS: Yes, we went up and down and saw everybody I thought that remained after the meeting on Friday.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Okay, I am glad you clarified that because I was not asked.

SENATOR LEWIS: We might have missed one or two but certainly the numbers were overwhelming. I am sure we got to at least 40 or 41 members and Senator DeCamp was responsible for contacting you and, obviously, he let down on that...no, that is not true. We attempted to get everybody who was in the Chambers afterwards and Senator DeCamp is not to blame for anybody we missed nor neither am I but we did get enough around that it was very clear to me and very clear to Senator DeCamp and very clear to the rest of the Committee what your sentiments were as of Friday, last.
