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Disney, you are the ones who made it all possible. I say let religion stay in the church like the churches say politics ought to stay in the Legislature. Maybe it is appropriate though, as I told the Executive Board, for the Legislature, which is worldly, to hire a mercenary merchant of God because the papacy hires mercenary Swiss soldiers. So I guess if the Holy See can hire mercenary worldly military people for money, then it is all right for the worldly Legislature to hire mercenary sellers of prayers. And don't get angry because I think Jesus warned you about these things. I think he told you in so many words that if you mishandle this sword it will turn around and cut you and, Senator Kremer, I don't believe in religion like you do but sometimes I wonder if there might be bits and shreds of truth in it all and that nobody knows why a person might be raised up.

PRESIDENT: One minute, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Nobody might know what purpose an individual is to serve but it will all shake out in the wash and our words will justify us or our words will condemn us. Our conduct here will show whether the Legislature is filled with the god-fearing individuals that this discussion would seem to indicate but, personally, I doubt it.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Stoney.

SENATOR STONEY: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, as one member of this body that was not polled regarding this issue, in considering the issue, the essence of the issue, that being that the former Board had made a determination which has been reversed, I would request a machine vote on those individuals that were polled and those that were not polled, those indicating with the sign "aye" having been polled and those that were not polled in the negative form so I would feel more comfortable with the fact that the majority of this body was polled and that the decision was reached that the original decision made by the Executive Board could be overridden by the new Board. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stoney, if the Chair may say this, that we will vote on the motion to proceed to the election which I think will be apoll in itself for what you can read that purpose into it. The Chair recognizes Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. President, I call for the previous question.

PRESIDENT: Do I see five hands? I do. All those in favor
