PRESIDENT: The motion carries and is approved and Chaplain Palmer has been elected as Chaplain of the Legislature. The Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Mr. President, Mr. Clerk, would you read that motion that I signed and then I have got a couple of other announcements.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Marvel would like to make an announcement and the Speaker announces that the Legislature will not meet on Friday, January 12th.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, that is the first announcement. We will go through Thursday this week. We will not meet on Friday. Senator Burrows has circulated a notice around to you inviting you to Beatrice on Thursday. Let me make this clear that the official representation of the Legislature at the Beatrice visit will consist of the Chairman of the Public Health and Welfare Committee and the Chairman of Appropriations. Anyone else who wishes to go, you are on your own. So you can, if you are interested, talk to Senator Burrows, if he has not talked to you. I would like to have a meeting of the Chairmen tomorrow morning at nine o'clock in Room 2102. One of the major things that we need to talk about is the 90 day schedule. We have a 90 day schedule almost complete. I want to bring it up before the Chairmen and then we will bring it up for you sometime tomorrow. Also may I announce that tomorrow on the agenda will be the discussion of the legislative resolutions that have been introduced so far. Senator Fowler wanted me to announce that tomorrow morning at 9:30 a.m. there will be a meeting of the Rules Committee. That is all, Mr. Clerk, I think, unless you have something else on the desk. Now what we need to do is encourage legislators to get those bills up there so we can get them introduced and the committee chairmen can begin to assign them so we can get the machinery moving.

PRESIDENT: Proceed with some announcements, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Marvel as former Chairman of the Exec Board gives notice of the selection of the members of the Nebraska Retirement Systems Committee. That Committee will consist of Senator Hasebroock as Chairman, Senator Frank Lewis, Fowler, Goodrich, Warner and Cullan.
