LB 3, 4, 5

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there a second to the motion? It has been moved and seconded that LB 3 be advanced to E & R Initial. The Chair recognizes Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: LB 3, these functions that it refers to, the Auditor of Public Accounts, it transfers this function from the Auditor of Public Accounts to the Director of Administrative Services which is the way it should be. Mr. Chairman, I move for the advancement of LB 3.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any further discussion? All those in favor of advancing the bill to E & R Initial vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: LB 3 is advanced to E & R Initial. The Clerk will read the title to LB 4.

CLERK: Read title to LB 4. The bill was first read on January 4, 1979. It was referred directly to General File, Mr. President.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, I move for the advancement of LB 4 to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there a second to the motion? The Chair recognizes Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: There are a number of situations where a particular section appears twice in the statutes because we had one penalty under January 1 and another penalty after such date. This bill harmonizes those sections with the criminal code and corrects the correlation problem which was merely renumbering of subsections.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any further discussion? All those in favor of advancing LB 4 to E & R Initial vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried, the bill is advanced. LB 5.
