SENATOR NICHOL: Madam Chairman, Thank you, Senator Murphy. I appreciate that and that is the way I would suggest that we do handle it.

SENATOR MARSH: I am sorry. Would you repeat that please?

SENATOR NICHOL: Madam Chairperson, I said that I thank Senator Murphy and I think this is the way we should handle it. Suspend the rules first and then act on the advancement of the bill.

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Murphy, according to the Clerk it was already sent directly to General File so that a vote to advance would be the same indication of the body's willingness.

SENATOR MURPHY: I am not familiar with the rule the Clerk is referring to. By what authority do we do this? It is my understanding that we can suspend our rules and permit introduction of a bill directly to General File.

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Murphy, the Reference Committee can refer directly to General File.

SENATOR MURPHY: Fine, thank you.

SENATOR NICHOL: Madam Chairman, would we then...?

SENATOR MARSH: It is Rule 3, Section 19, Senator Murphy. Thank you. We are now ready and we will vote on the advancement of LB 7.

CLERK: Senator Marsh voting aye.

SENATOR MARSH: The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 33 ayes and 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SENATOR MARSH: LB 7 is advanced to E & R Initial. The Clerk will read some announcements.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Revenue gives notice of public hearing in Room 1520 for the week of January 15, signed Senator Carsten, Chairman. Mr. President, Senator Fitzgerald advises the body that the Transportation Advisory Committee will meet today at 3:00 p.m. in Room 2022 for an organizational meeting.
