PRESIDENT LUEDTKE PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: Prayer by the Chaplain, Dr. Robert Palmer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer offered.

PRESIDENT: Roll call.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Sieck and Newell would like to be excused until they arrive.

Mr. President, Senator Frank Lewis would like to be excused Monday the 15th and Tuesday the 16th, all day.

PRESIDENT: Have you all registered your presence? Record the roll call.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Chair would like to take the opportunity at this time to introduce some guests of Senator Koch; 10 students from Ralston High School with Larry Keane, Political Science class. They're up here in the south balcony, I imagine. I don't see them. Is this the class? Stand up and be recognized please.

The Chair recognizes Senator Fowler for the purpose of a motion on Rules.

SENATOR FOWLER: Would the Clerk read the motion?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Fowler moves that we adopt the Rules as now in our possession for the Eighty-Sixth Legislature, First Session.

SENATOR FOWLER: This is a motion to adopt the Rules as they are in the Rule Book on your desk; no amendments or changes. Amendments will be brought in later, but right now it's to adopt, for the rest of the session, the Rules as they are in that little book on your desk.

PRESIDENT: Is there any discussion? All in favor of adopting the present Rules as the continuing Rules, so that we do not have to take this up each and every day, all of those in favor signify by voting aye. Opposed nay. Again it will require 30 votes for the adoption of the Rules. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 36 ayes, no nays on the adoption of the permanent Rules, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The permanent Rules are adopted. The Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel.
