LB 76

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: I have a motion on the desk.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Dworak asks unanimous consent that we expedite LB 76.

PRESIDENT: The motion is unanimous consent that we expedite this bill. Is there any objection? If not, so ordered. Proceed, Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move that LB 76 be moved to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: All right, motion to advance LB 76 to E & R Initial. Is there any discussion? Senator Duis, did you... Senator Duis. The Chair recognizes Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Well, what does...Mr. Chairman.

PRESIDENT: Yes, Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: I would like to ask Senator Dworak what does this bill do. I'm sorry, I was...

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak, would you care to respond to Senator Nichol's inquiry?

SENATOR DWORAK: Senator Nichol, this is a bill that results from the action we took last year when Senator Labeledz extended the Homestead Exemption to mobile home owners. They report at a different time than those people...other people that report real estate. All we're doing is putting that reporting date the same to facilitate that in February, and that's the need for the....why we need to expedite it.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator Dworak, I heartily support your bill.

SENATOR DWORAK: That was Senator Maxey's amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion then on LB 76 motion to advance to E & R Initial? If not, all those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes; 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.
