LB 68, 70 and 76

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any further discussion? Is there any close, Senator Warner? The motion is to advance LB 70 to E & R Initial. It takes 25 votes. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Clerk record the vote.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried and the bill is advanced.

Reports from the Clerk's desk.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Revenue gives notice of public hearing for Wednesday, January 24. Signed Senator Carsten, Chairman. (See Page 275 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports that we have carefully examined and reviewed Legislative Bill 68 and recommend that same be placed on Select File. 76 placed on Select File with amendments. Signed Senator Wesely, Chairman. (See Page 276 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any other reports?

CLERK: No, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Before we proceed to Item #6, I would like to call something to the attention of the Legislature. We have introduced 535 bills. We have 80 days to process these bills. The bills...the Reference Committee will meet this morning to refer at least a hundred bills. The Speaker would encourage committee chairmen to assign the bills as rapidly as possible. I assume there will be a number of bills that will not see the light of day because of the strength of the committees, and that then we will have an orderly process from the committees to the floor of the Legislature. Please keep in mind...please keep this in mind when you are requested to introduce additional bills. Some of them will be emergency bills. Others perhaps can wait until another session. 535 bills...80 days to process these bills.

The Chair recognizes Senator Frank Lewis for Item #6, which has to do with the Political Accountability Reports, and the information is on Page 187 of the Journal. Senator Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. President, I have a motion up there for the approval of the names as submitted to you by the Executive Board. You can see those names. The Executive Board determined
