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shall hurt no one. We'll know what the rules are for the next time. It's the only way you can do this. You cannot make the change after you've elected the leadership. The change has to be made now in preparation for the future, and I think for that reason this is a good viable compromise, the two year delay, and the rules change will strengthen our committee system. It will help us better understand the executive branch, and better understand those appointments that come before us. It is one way that we can strengthen this body and do like so many other legislatures across the country, as the federal government does so that they better can understand the process and the activities of the department. I would urge you to support this. Thank you. Mr. President... Mr. President...

SPEAKER MARVEL: Excuse me.

SENATOR NEWELL: Because the Executive Board is out of the Chamber I would like to have a Call of the House before the vote, so we could bring those people back in and proceed with the vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I don't think the Executive Board is out. If you want a Call of the House that's...

SENATOR NEWELL: Well I'd like to have a Call of the House. There's a whole lot of members gone.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are you asking for a Call of the House?

SENATOR NEWELL: Please, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question is shall the House go under Call. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Okay, record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All members will take their seats. Unauthorized personnel please leave the Chamber. Please record your presence. While we're waiting for members to record their presence, I would like to announce first of all that Senator Haberman had Mr. Ron Milner, Manager of the Upper Republican Resources District as his guest. He has now left, but we shall record it in the Journal.
