SPEAKER MARVEL: The Clerk has some reports to read in.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Public Health and Welfare, whose Chairman is Senator Cullan to whom we referred Legislative Bill 34, instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation that it be advanced to General File. Signed Senator Cullan, Chairman. (See Page 278 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Clerk will read an announcement.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Duis moves that the Legislature authorize the Standing Committees to meet at 10:30 a.m., 1:30 p.m., and 2:00 p.m. for the weeks of January 22 through 26, January 29 through February 2, and February 5 through February 9. That's offered by Senator Duis.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, this motion I believe is necessary according to our rules so that we may divert from the 2:00 p.m. standard time in the rule, which I believe is Rule 3, Section 4, and consequently the Legislature must approve the deviation from the 2:00 p.m. time.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I only rise for a question of Senator Duis, and it's this Senator Duis...if I may, Mr. President...

SPEAKER MARVEL: Go ahead.

SENATOR CARSTEN: We set bills for 10:30 in the morning. They may be controversial bills, they may not, but in the event that they are and we go by the 12:00 time, 1:30 may very well be a hurried time for the committee and those that want to testify to get back. Is there going to be, or will there be permitted a leeway there so that in the event we need to to set it at 2:00 as opposed to 1:30?

SENATOR DUIS: Senator Carsten, I don't think you need to set a time if you're in continuation, you will merely recess rather than meet.
