LB 68, 34

Mr. President, Senator Hefner offers explanation of vote.

PRESIDENT: We are then ready for a suspension and the Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I move that the rules be suspended and we take up LB 68 on Final Reading. It will take about five minutes.

PRESIDENT: Motion before the House is the suspension of rules in order that we might take up LB 68 on Final Reading. Is there any discussion? All those in favor of the motion to suspend the rules for the purpose of taking up LB 68 for Final Reading vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to suspend the rules, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion is approved. The rules are suspended and, Mr. Clerk, you will proceed then to read LB 68 on Final Reading. Will the Sergeant at Arms clear the floor? Will all nonlegislative personnel leave the floor of the Legislature at this time? Will all legislators be at their desks for the purpose of Final Reading? Again, we are going to try to keep everyone at their desks and the Clerk will read as quickly and distinctly as possible the words found in LB 68. Here come Senator Lewis and Simon so we can now go ahead with the reading of LB 68.

CLERK: Read LB 68 on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 68 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 317, Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 0 nays, 6 excused and not voting and 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 68 passes with the emergency clause attached. We move to agenda item #6 to Select File, LB 34. The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move LB 34 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: There are E & R amendments, Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Okay, then I move the E & R amendments.
