

It is just that that word "reasonable" scares me.

SENATOR KREMER: Senator Murphy, if or not we want to advance the bill, I don't know, but if we do, I'd be happy to pose a question to the Attorney General related to your problem you bring up.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I was not listening to the conversation or to all the debate on this. I was with the Exec Board over there. However, I scanned the bill quickly and it appears to be, and you can explain this to me, an extremely major bill for my part of the territory. Question, does this overturn the Madison County case? Is that what in effect it is? Yes, whoever.

SENATOR KREMER: Senator DeCamp, in my opening remarks I said that we are dealing with two different kinds of problems. An artesian aquifer is entirely different than a confined aquifer where most of our wells are drilled. An artesian aquifer is one where the water is under pressure and you know that just like I do. So in my opinion, this would in no way overturn the decision made by the courts as related to the Madison case. It was resolved at that time.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Okay, then I won't pursue it any further at this time and I will just do some additional studying on it. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: I have a question of Senator Kremer, one further question.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kremer, will you respond for further question from Senator Dworak?

SENATOR DWORAK: Senator Kremer, in your explanation, in your opening remarks, you indicated that this is but the first block in the subsequent legislation that is to come and I imagine this has been well thought out if this is that important foundation piece. If this piece is so directly related to subsequent legislation, Senator Kremer, could you touch upon that relationship and what other legislation you have in mind that will be forthcoming that necessitates the passage of this bill?
