those who wish to either challenge or those who wish to defend so there are two issues. I think it is absolutely necessary that we stick to the agenda and if you don't want to stick to the agenda then we once again I will say what I did the other day, we just as well throw it out the window. So, number one, you have a bill request on your desk by the Judiciary Committee. It will be on the agenda for tomorrow. I would also alert the Judges Association that this Legislature is not going to be open continually to request for additional bills unless they are absolutely necessary. We can't go on indefinitely meeting requests of various groups who for some reason or another failed to follow the regular procedure that the rest of us have to follow, and, secondly, look over the reference report of the Exec Board and be prepared for an item on the agenda for tomorrow which will be a challenge, as I recall, to either three or four different bills. Thank you, Mr. President. That is all of the lecturing I have to do for the day and I will yield to Senator Lewis if he has a comment, with the permission of the Chair.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Senator Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. Chairman, I think since we're going to obviously have a floor fight over the issue of references I would invite those that have been cooperative enough to agree to leave their bills where they were that brought forth the complaints to me and graciously let it ride to come forward now and make any change that you want to and file those tomorrow and that includes some of the other legislation that some of you historically thought ought to go to your committee anyway. So if we are going to vote on each and every one of these issues, let's just not designate it to two or three that some individuals want. So I would say if we are going to take these to the floor and fight about it... Senator Marvel, this is the way I would do it.
