LB 537

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, it is a bill relating to agriculture; to change licensing dates; to change provisions relating to nonresidents; to eliminate nonresident's permits; to delete provisions relating to a disease; to repeal the original sections.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Is that request #792?

CLERK: #793, Senator.

SENATOR SCHMIT: This is a bill requested by the Department of Agriculture. It deletes obsolete language in the sale of nursery stock. It is a bill to clean up the language and I request the introduction of the bill and I move that it be introduced.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Any further discussion? The question before the house then is introduction of request #793 by the Agriculture Committee. It requires 30 votes. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? We are voting on the introduction of request #793 by the Agriculture Committee. It requires 30 votes. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the introduction of the bill, Mr. President.

Mr. President, new bill, LB 537 introduced by the committee on Ag and Environment. (Read LB 537 by title for the first time. See page 341 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: The Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel.

SPEAKER MARVEL: What is the number of that request?

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: 793.

SPEAKER MARVEL: That puts it 537. It wasn't on the agenda. Okay.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, what was the request number? We just had request number...

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: That was LB 537.

SENATOR SCHMIT: What was the request number?

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: The request number was 793.
