SENATOR SCHMIT: This is the one that relates to the sale of nursery stock?

CLERK: Right. That was the one we just did.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Well what is the request number now?

CLERK: 801.

SENATOR SCHMIT: 801. This one provides authority for the Department of Agriculture to administer the corn and soybean acts. Those two acts are being presently administered by the department. The various agencies do not have that authority to contract with those individuals and those groups and therefore we need to give them that authority. I move for the introduction of the bill.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Any further discussion? Motion by the Ag Committee to introduce request # 801. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. It will require 30 votes. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the introduction of the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Motion carries. Read the bill.

CLERK: Read LB 538 by title for the first time. (See page 341 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR SCHMIT: What is the request number?

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: 801. This was 801.

SENATOR SCHMIT: No, we just completed 801.

CLERK: 792 is the next one, Senator.

SENATOR SCHMIT: 792 provides for a change in the registration period for commercial feed. To the present time they had to be registered every year. The department feels that it is unnecessary to do that and this provides that the registration period be for three years. I move for the introduction of the bill.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: All right, the motion before the house is the introduction of request #792. Is there any discussion? If not, all those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. It requires 30 votes. Would you like to have a Call of the House, Senator Schmit, so we can get everybody in here?
