SENATOR SCHMIT: I suppose.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Maybe if we have a Call of the House we will get everybody in here and then we can finish this job. Record the vote.

CLERK: Read LB 539 by title for the first time. (See page 342 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, this bill provides a penalty for the late payment of fees relating to weights and measures. At the present time there is no penalty and the registrations come in from all periods of time and the department feels it would be of great assistance to them to have a penalty and I move for the introduction of the bill.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Is there any discussion on request #791? If not, all those in favor vote aye, opposed nay for the introduction of request #791 by the Ag Committee. It requires 30 votes. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Schmit, I'm going to call the vote. Do you want me to call it? Record the vote.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I guess I'm going to have to ask for a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: All right. All those in favor of a Call of the House vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: The House is under call. The Sergeant at Arms will bring in all the members of the Legislature. All legislators will return to their seats. Senator Schmit, do you want to take votes at this time?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Let's take votes, yes.

PRESIDENT: All right, we will take votes.

CLERK: Senator Nichol voting aye, Senator Reutzel voting aye, Senator George voting aye, Senator Frank Lewis voting aye. 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to introduce the bill.
