

Will they stand and be recognized? They are under the South balcony. Welcome all of you to the Legislature on this blustery morning. We will now then proceed with the Final Reading of LB 70, Mr. Clerk, and will all legislators return to their desks, all nonlegislators leave the floor of the Legislature and the Sergeant at Arms keep the aisles cleared. The Clerk will wait for all the legislators to be at their desks. Proceed then with the reading of LB 70.

CLERK: Read LB 70 on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 70 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: Read record vote found on page 343 of the Legislative Journal. 38 ayes, 0 nays, 8 excused and not voting, and 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: LB 70 passes with the emergency clause attached. Ready for agenda item #7, Select File, LB 289. The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I move LB 289 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Motion is to advance LB 289 to E & R for engrossment. Any discussion? All those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. LB 289 is advanced to E & R for engrossment. That will complete Select File. Next agenda item #8, Committee (mike not working properly) and the Chair recognizes Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I ask unanimous consent to withdraw the report in your Journal and to substitute the report which the Clerk will now read.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Is there any objection to the request? So ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Marsh substitutes the report regarding the Energy Committee. There is a communication from Senator Marsh. (Read communication from Senator Marsh found on page 344 of the Legislative Journal.)
