Senator Marsh, do you want to proceed?

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. President, I ask for a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: All right. A roll call vote has been requested and we will reread the motion one more time. Is that what you want, Senator Dworak? Okay. We will reread, at this point, we will reread the motion one more time. Go ahead, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Reread motion.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: All right, now we will have a roll call vote, Mr. Clerk.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Announce the vote.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 17 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Motion fails. The Chair recognizes Senator Marsh.
