

very eloquent speech that none the less we do need the Dworak amendment and I certainly hope that you would endorse it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Chair recognizes Senator Dworak for the purposes of closing.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, members I'll be brief. It is my understanding and I went out and talked to the people out in the rotunda and they seem to be the people that are now passing legislation rather than this body. But, it is my understanding that the Medical Association had requested that miotics be deleted. They had requested that this drug not be in there. The optometrist would not accept that request and as a consequence another one of these ill conceived compromises were forged out. I think that when Senator Clark has purported over and over again that the Medical Association, and he is indicating has said that miotics should be in there as qualified, that is a little bit misleading because their first reaction, their first proposition, their first proposal was that miotics be deleted. I think that they and whoever they are will substantiate this particular situation. Senator Clark again has used the word "treat" we need miotics to treat. That is not what the intent of LB 9 is all about. LB 9 is intended to diagnose and diagnosis only, not to treat. So, I think with Senator Clark's explanation that miotics are used very, very seldomly, very rare, he alluded to the snail darter that rare, and really it is needed for treatment rather than diagnosis, I think, to stay in compliance with the intent of LB 9 we adopt this amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Dworak amendment to LB 9. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: There are eleven people not voting and I would like a.....

SPEAKER MARVEL: You have 25 nays Senator Dworak. It is impossible.

SENATOR DWORAK: But it would be a record as to who....

SPEAKER MARVEL: You want a record vote?

SENATOR DWORAK: Please.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, a record vote has been required.
