PRESIDENT LUEDTKE PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: Prayer by Chaplain Palmer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer offered.

PRESIDENT: Roll call.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Koch would like to be excused until he arrives and Senator Brennan all day.

PRESIDENT: Have you all recorded your presence? Record the roll call.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have no corrections to the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Notices, reports and announcements.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Business and Labor whose Chairman is Senator Maresh to whom was referred LB 67 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File with amendments.

Mr. President, your committee on Government, Military and Veterans Affairs whose Chairman is Senator Keyes to whom was referred LB 22 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File; LB 38 advanced to General File with amendments; LB 85 advanced to General File with amendments; and LB 115 advanced to General File with amendments.
