CLERK: Senator Clark voting aye. Senator Kremer voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Have you all recorded your presence? The House is under Call. Will all legislators return to the Chamber and to their desk? Record your presence. We are accepting call-in votes. Senator Carsten, Senator Duis is the only one. All right. Record the vote then.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 10 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the motion.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. We are still under Call. Does anyone want to make a motion? Senator Rumery. Motion to raise the Call. All those in favor say aye, opposed nay. The Call is raised. Anything further, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move LB 150 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Motion to advance LB 150 to E & R for engrossment. Any discussion? All those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. LB 150 is advanced to E & R for engrossment. That will conclude Select File. Anything to be read in?

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports we have carefully examined LB 34 and find the same correctly enrolled. Signed Senator Wesely, Chairman.

PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of doing business, I propose to sign and I do sign LB 34.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Enrolling Clerk respectfully reports that she has on this day at 9:15 a.m. presented to the Governor for his approval the following bills: LB 76 and LB 70.
