LB 192, 128, 95

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced. Next is LB 128 (E).

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 128 was a bill introduced by the Education Committee and signed by the members thereof. Read title. The bill was first read on January 9 of this year. It was referred to the Education Committee. The bill was advanced to General File, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Kahle, the Vice Chairman of the Education Committee. Do you wish to move the advancement of the bill?

SENATOR KAHLE: Mr. Chairman, members of the body, I move the advancement of LB 128 to E & R Initial. I think it is pretty much self-explanatory. The Clerk read the intent. It would bypass the local school district from having to handle this money. The money comes directly to the people that provide the service and there were no objections in committee hearing and it was voted out unanimously. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any further discussion on the motion to advance the bill? Okay, the motion is to advance LB 128 to E & R Review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried and the bill is advanced. We now move to LB 95.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 95. Read title. The bill was first read on January 5 of this year. It was referred to the Public Health and Welfare Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are no amendments pending.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Cullan, are you prepared to discuss LB 95 through LB 98?

SENATOR CULLAN: Yes, Mr. President.
