LB 95, 96, 97

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced. Do you want to read LB 96?

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 96. Title read. The bill was first read on January 5. It was referred to the Public Health and Welfare Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are no amendments pending.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that LB 96 be advanced from General File to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, LB 96 is also a product of the sunset review process. The bill was drafted at their request. There was a public hearing on this bill as well as LB 95, 97 and 98 by the Public Health Committee prior to its drafting in November or December sometime. All that LB 96 is intended to re-establish the Board of Examiners in Veterinary Medicine. There is some additional intent language or language in LB 96 which describes some of the functions of the Board of Examiners in Veterinary Medicine. I do not believe that there are any substantive changes in statute or that this will significantly affect their operation. The bill is necessary to continue the Board of Examiners in Veterinary Medicine.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any further discussion on LB 96? The motion is to advance the bill to E & R Review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are ready for LB 97. I am sorry, the motion is carried and the bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 97. Title read. The bill was read on January 5 of this year. It was referred to the Public Health and Welfare Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are no amendments pending.
