PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: That might not be a bad idea. Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: I will rescind my motion as to remain...

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Do you want to move again so we.... Technically we came out of the Call. I think it is a good idea.

SENATOR NICHOL: I will ask for a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: All right, a motion to have a Call of the House. All those in favor vote aye. Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, to go under Call.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: The House is back under Call. The Sergeant at Arms will bring back all the members of the Legislature. All legislators will be in their seats. Record your presence. While you are recording your presence the Clerk will read the title to the bill that was just introduced.

CLERK: (Read LB 548 by title for the first time. See page 389 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: We will take up then, Mr. Clerk, Request # 666. The Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the introduction of the bills. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, what this bill does, it is an appropriation bill for capital construction that the University of Nebraska for a chiller on the East Campus and the reason we are putting it in as a separate bill is if, in the event we need to act on this earlier than the regular appropriation bills, it is available to do. The hearing for it will be held in connection with the regular hearing on the University budget but there is a contract or a bid rather, on this that is available and there are penalty provisions on that bid if it is not accepted after a certain series of dates. Should it be probable that this will be voted by the Legislature, then it may be appropriate to be able to do it earlier. So that is the reason we are putting it in as a separate bill rather than outside of the regular appropriation bill.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: The Chair recognizes Senator Dworak.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, to make it so there is no misunderstanding, this bill will come back to the committee
