PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Seeing none other wishing to speak, the question before the house is the introduction of Request #666. It will require 30 votes. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. I remind you that the House is under Call. All legislators to be at their desks. Record the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to introduce.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Motion carries. The bill is introduced. Read the bill, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 549 by title for the first time. May be found on pages 389-390 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: We will take up Request #826, Appropriations Committee. The Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, this is a proposed bill which again will be referred to committee for a hearing. It establishes a procedure for the consideration of appropriations by the Legislature.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Any further discussion? All those in favor of introducing Request #836 by the Appropriations Committee vote aye, opposed nay. This will require 30 votes. Record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to introduce, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: The motion passes. The bill is introduced. Read the bill, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 550 by title for the first time. May be found on page 390 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Mr. Speaker, shall we try to finish these up since the House is under Call?

SPEAKER MARVEL: What do we have, three left?

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I think while we are under Call you ought to finish.
