Consequently I did not go into the program like I probably should have so I could have answered your question.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Thank you, Senator Kremer. I will look into it myself. Thank you very much.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Motion on the desk. Read the motion, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lamb moves to amend on page 3 of the bill, strike all the new language and reinsert the old.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: The Chair recognizes Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I guess I am a little bit reluctant to place the determination of the property values in the hands of one person. I think it would have a tendency to be fair, be much more equitable if we leave it as it was where three people decide what the value is. Perhaps it would be more acceptable to all those concerned if they thought there was a committee there establishing the price rather than one person. I would ask the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Senator Keyes, do you wish to speak to the amendment? All right, Senator Kahle, do you wish to speak to the amendment?

SENATOR KAHLE: Mr. President, members of the body, I feel the same I believe as Senator Lamb does. I think it would be to the advantage of the landowner to have more than one opinion. As you know the art of appraisal is a matter of judgement in many cases and I feel that having taken part in several appraisal activities, know that sometimes three people do not agree on exact price and usually a compromise can be met that will satisfy everybody concerned. Mr. President, I would like to speak also on the bill when it comes up so I will leave my light on.
