save some money and, secondly, we will get a better job from a licensed appraiser than we will from a three man committee.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Senator Lamb, you may close on your amendment.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I think Senator Cullan makes my point very well when he says that if people are not satisfied with the appraisers opinion they can go to court and that is what I am trying to avoid. I submit that there is a much better chance of a three man committee coming up with an equitable value and that the expense of this is going to be minimal in comparison with the expense of going to court. I think it is a much better system as it is now and that licensing of an appraiser does not automatically make his judgement infallible. I request that the amendment be adopted please.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: The question before the house is the adoption of the Lamb amendment to LB 31. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. It requires 25 votes. Senator Lamb, for your information seven people are absent today so there is no way.... Record the vote.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 19 nays on the adoption of Senator Lamb's amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: The motion fails. The Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel since the time has elapsed for today's activities.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I move that we adjourn until nine o'clock, Monday. Do you have something to read in? I will withhold the motion a minute.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: All right, hold up the motion just for some reading.
