PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit. The Chair recognizes Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, request permission to withdraw the hearing on this bill because we will probably reschedule it at a later date and it is not necessary to hold it right now. We may not have to.

PRESIDENT: All right, so we have to suspend the rules to withdraw this hearing. Is there any discussion? A similar request to what we had earlier. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. This will require 30 votes to suspend for this purpose. Record the vote.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays on the rules suspension, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. They are suspended. The hearing is cancelled. Yes, read some matters in.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Miscellaneous Subjects gives notice of public hearing in Room 2230 for February 15, signed, Senator Newell, Chairman.

Mr. President, Senator Carsten offers a proposed rule change which will properly be referred to the Rules Committee.

PRESIDENT: Let's raise the Call. The Chair recognizes Senator Goodrich for purposes of raising the Call.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Raise the Call.

PRESIDENT: If there is no objection, the call is raised. Go ahead.

CLERK: Mr. President, a new resolution, LR 13. Read. (See page 428, Legislative Journal.) Mr. President, that will properly be laid over.

PRESIDENT: The Speaker is going to move to, unless there is an objection, is going to move to item #7, Select File, since that is all the time that will be left this morning. So unless there is an objection, we will proceed then down to Select File, agenda item #7. Any objection? Hearing none, so ordered.
