SPEAKER MARVEL: Now, Senator Koch. Senator Clark, we read your motion in. We have to hold it at that until I address Senator Koch. Senator Koch.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, you can amend.

SENATOR CLARK: I would amend his motion with mine.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, do I get to speak on my motion and explain it before it is amended? I think basically it is the same thing Senator Clark is trying to do.
