SPEAKER MARVEL: The Dworak amendment as amended by the Clark amendment is passed. Now, Senator Clark, what do you wish to do with the bill?

SENATOR CLARK: I would move that it be advanced to E & R engrossing. Are there any other amendments?

SPEAKER MARVEL: No.

SENATOR CLARK: I'd move it be advanced to E & R engrossing.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor say aye. A machine vote has been called for. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 9 nays on the advancement of the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. The Clerk has some announcements to read into the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, first of all, Senator Warner asks unanimous consent to print a motion in the Legislative Journal.

Mr. President, your committee on Agriculture and Environment whose Chairman is Senator Schmit to whom was referred LB 25 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File; LB 140 advanced to General File. Signed Senator Schmit, Chairman.

Mr. President, your committee on Constitutional Revision and Recreation whose Chairman is Senator Reutzel to whom we referred LB 78 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File with amendments; LB 434 advanced to General File with amendments; LB 435 advanced to General File with amendments; LB 437 advanced to General File with amendments; LB 100 indefinitely postponed; LB 189 indefinitely postponed; LB 446 indefinitely postponed. Signed, Senator Reutzel, Chairman.
