LB 56, 90A

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. President, members, I would vote for the advancement of 90A. This is \$2,400. It is merely their authority to spend the money. It is not General Fund money. It is a cash funded agency by themselves but they have to have authority to spend the money. That is all the bill does.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator George, do you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR GEORGE: Yes, just a quick question of Senator Clark.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Clark.

SENATOR GEORGE: Is this one initial A bill in order to establish a cash fund which does not exist yet or do we have to put that in every year?

SENATOR CLARK: You have to give them the authority to spend the money. It is still a cash funded agency but they can not spend any cash funds....

SENATOR GEORGE: Once that cash is there and it can rotate, do we still have to come back every year for an A bill to allow for compensation of the commission?

SENATOR CLARK: No, no, you just have to have the authority for it is all.

SENATOR GEORGE: This is just a one time shot to establish the cash fund?

SENATOR CLARK: Yes, it will be in their budget otherwise.

SENATOR GEORGE: Okay, thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance 90A to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced. The Clerk will read LB 56.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 56 is a bill introduced by Senator Robert Clark of the 47th. (Read title to LB 56.)
