SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes, it has been.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Are you on the Exec Board, Reference Board?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes, I am.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. President, the report is on page 451 and 452. I ask for the confirmation by the Nebraska Legislature of the following names: George Miller to the Nebraska Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education; Rex Kelly, State Board of Health; Bennard Preis, Manufactured Housing Advisory Board; Clifford Dudley, Manufactured Housing Advisory Board; and J. E. Clemens, Manufactured Housing Advisory Board.

PRESIDENT: And you wish to vote on these all at one time?

SENATOR MARSH: Yes, Mr. President.
