ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 98 on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of the law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 98 pass with the emergency clause attached? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 491, Legislative Journal.) The vote is 45 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 98 passes with the emergency clause attached. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 128.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 128 on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 128 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See pages 491 and 492, Legislative Journal.) The vote is 43 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 128 passes with the emergency clause attached. The Clerk will now read the final bill for today's Final Reading, LB 192.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 192 on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 192 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See pages 492 and 493, Legislative Journal.) The vote is 44 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.
