Koch, I think it might even be a more fair consideration to give him an opportunity to have his input and maybe run that amendment past the Department of Education one more time and see if they can describe a bus.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion on Senator Chambers' motion to return LB 131 to committee? Senator Chambers, do you wish to close on your motion? No close. The question is whether to return LB 131 to the Judiciary Committee. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. This will require 25 votes. Have you all voted? Motion to return to committee. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 7 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The bill is returned to the Judiciary Committee. We will proceed then with the next bill on General File, LB 117. Mr. Clerk, read the bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 117. Read title. The bill was first read on January 8 of this year. It was referred to the Judiciary Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. Mr. President, there are committee amendments pending by Senator Nichol's Judiciary Committee.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature, this bill has to do with the small claims court and the amount of money, the maximum amount of money which this court can handle. The bill was originally put in at \$2,000, to raise it from \$500 to \$2,000 and the committee amended the bill to read \$750 as the maximum amount.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion on the committee amendment? If not, all those in favor of adopting the committee amendment... Senator Beutler. The Chair recognizes Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, I think there is an amendment to the committee amendment with the Clerk.

PRESIDENT: Is there a motion on the desk? Motion on the desk then.

CLERK: Mr. President. Read Johnson amendment found on page 494, Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Johnson.
