PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Question.

PRESIDENT: Do I see five hands? I do. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Debate ceases. Senator Nichol, do you want to close again on this motion.

SENATOR NICHOL: Is this on the amendment?

PRESIDENT: This is on the amendment.

SENATOR NICHOL: Okay, I waive closing.

PRESIDENT: All right. Motion is to adopt the committee amendment as amended. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 5 nays on the adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion passes. The committee amendment is adopted as amended. The Chair recognizes Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, I move for the advancement of LB 117.

PRESIDENT: Motion to advance to E & R Initial. Any discussion? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay to advance LB 117 to E & R Initial. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 7 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. LB 117 is advanced. The next bill on General File is LB 10.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 10. Read title. The bill was read on January 4. It was referred to the Constitutional Revision and Recreation Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending by Senator Reutzel's Constitutional Revision and Recreation Committee.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Reutzel.
