PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: A question for Senator Reutzel. I didn't understand the explanation for the changing of sections in line 14. Apparently the current law requires these funds to be used for the administration and enforcement of 81-815. You now change that that it is for the administration of 37-1201 and the other. There must be something very significant about changing one whole section to a different section of law, different chapter, I mean. Could you explain what that is?

SENATOR REUTZEL: Senator Warner, I would have to check with committee counsel on that. You may have a point there but this was discussed in committee and I think this was the intent of the committee and I would check with counsel if you care.
