CLERK: Senator Brennan voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Mr. Sergeant at Arms, Senator Johnson, Senator Haberman, Senator Goodrich, Senator Simon. Senator Cullan voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Cullan voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Reutzel, you have to take your seat.

CLERK: Senator Goodrich voting aye. Senator Hasebroock voting aye.
