PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: I call the question.

PRESIDENT: All right, the question has been called for. Do I see five hands? I do. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Debate ceases and, Senator Simon, you may close on the advance of the bill. You waive closing? Senator Simon waives closing.

SENATOR SIMON: Move we advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: Motion to advance the bill. Motion is then the advancing of LB 53. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 8 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. LB 53 is advanced to E & R Initial. Some matters to read in, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Yes, sir.

PRESIDENT: Proceed to read them in.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Public Works whose chairman is Senator Kremer to whom is referred LB 23 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation that it be advanced to General File with amendments; LB 476 advanced to General File; LB 477 advanced to General File, signed, Senator Kremer, Chairman.

Mr. President, your committee on Government, Military and Veterans Affairs whose chairman is Senator Keyes to whom is referred LB 75 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation that it be advanced to General File with amendments; 137 advanced to General File with amendments; LB 30 indefinitely postponed; LB 64 indefinitely postponed; LB 109 indefinitely postponed, signed, Senator Keyes, Chairman.
