PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of the first part of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the first part of the committee amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The first part of the amendment is adopted. That means the entire committee amendment is adopted. We're now on the bill as a whole. Senator Haberman, do you have anything further on the advance of LB 115?

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President, I think we've discussed it long enough. We used up enough time. I will close on that.

PRESIDENT: The motion then is to advance LB 115. Any further discussion? If not, all those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President on the motion to advance.

CLERK: Mr. President, Legislative Bill 194 is a bill introduced by the Appropriations Committee and signed by the members thereof. (Read by title LB 194). The bill was first read on January 10 and was referred to the Appropriations Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are no amendments pending, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Chairman Warner.
