

SENATOR MURPHY: I was quite sure in my own mind that that would be covered under your proposal. My question now is where we do not have an A bill, where we're appropriating money in these bills with less than the A bill requirement in amount, will we add a form...will we add a requirement, will we require the information you're setting forth there in bills under the A bill size requirement? Will this apply to any bill that appropriates money even though it might not require an A bill?

SENATOR WARNER: Well, if there isn't an A bill, there isn't any...unless there's an appropriation contained in the act itself theoretically that shouldn't cost any money.

SENATOR MURPHY: That's what I'm, I guess, alluding to. If we do, in fact, put it in the bill and appropriate that money in that specific bill, will we have this same information where there is not a separate A bill?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes, that is the requirement. Yes, in part this would be one of the areas that we've had problems and this is to correct it so that the language is in there, that there is hereby appropriated that it does identify where there is cash funds, general funds, federal funds, whatever the exact dollar amount.

SENATOR MURPHY: So it will be applicable to all bills regardless of the amount of the fund whether it is appropriated by an A bill or by the bill itself?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes.

SENATOR MURPHY: Thank you.

SENATOR WARNER: And if it doesn't meet this specific criteria it is not an appropriation.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion on the Committee amendment on LB 232? Senator Warner, is there any close? Closing is waived. The motion before the House then is the adoption of the committee amendment on LB 232. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to adopt the committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Warner, anything further on the bill?
