SPEAKER MARVEL: I think there is an amendment to the committee amendments. The Chair recognizes Senator Hefner. Oh, I'm sorry, Clerk, you want to read the amendment?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hefner moves to amend the committee amendments. (Read Hefner amendment. See Page 528 of the Legislative Journal.) That's offered by Senator Hefner.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you move the adoption of the amendment, Senator Hefner?

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I move for the adoption of the amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the Chair recognizes Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, all this would do is require the ESUs, the NRDs and the Tech Colleges to make their request in writing, and the reason for this amendment is that I talked to some of the county treasurers from the northeast district yesterday and they say that sometimes they feel if these subdivisions of government can do it by telephone that they don't really know the importance of this. And, of course, this is going to require the county treasurers a little more work, and they feel that if they have to put it by writing well then they really want the information. I move for the adoption of this amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Carsten, do you wish to be recognized on the Hefner amendment?

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I would support Senator Hefner's amendment, and as he stated we have had some comments even though they came in and supported the bill in its original form, they have had some comments to us since then and I think that it is an answer to their foreseeable problem that might come about. I think that we need to work with them and for them, if we can. I support the amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Hefner
