

amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. This is the amendment to the committee amendments. Okay, record the vote.

CLERK: 21 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Hefner's amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. We're now ready for the committee amendments as amended. Do you have any further discussion, Senator Carsten? All those in favor of the committee amendments as amended vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes, do you wish to be recognized? The committee amendments are adopted. We're now ready to discuss the bill as amended. Do you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, I do. I want either Senator Hefner or Senator Carsten to tell me what the county treasurer is going to have to do now, and how much more work it's going to require in his office, if it's something that he is not doing or he is doing now, and someone ought to be able to tell me and I...it doesn't contain an A bill, it's not going to cost the state any more money, but how much more money is it going to put on the back for our county treasurer to do? If some... either one of you two gentlemen can tell me what these reports are...or any idea what they're going to cost, I'd like to know, and what are we going to gain by having this knowledge before us? Where is the source of revenue?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Carsten, you...

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, the real basis for it is to provide the information to those governmental subdivisions so that they know exactly where their money's coming from, and it's for informational reasons. Now, the county officials are not uptight on the added cost, if there be any added cost. This information is available as I understand it. It's merely a matter of putting it together and getting it out to these governmental subdivisions. The county officials did not bring to our attention added cost. If it was a real problem, or a serious problem, I'm sure they would have appeared in opposition to the bill on that basis. But I believe that the information is there. All they need to do is put it together and forward it to them.
