

Committee amendments. Senator George.

SENATOR GEORGE: Mr. President, I move the committee amendments. As you can see on your white copy, some of them are technical and one of them with...on Page 3 we, in order to standardize, we have prescribed there that...which is in conformance with the latest edition of the Federal Highway Administration Manual on uniform traffic control devices, so that we won't come up with anything separate from what people do either in the state or in other parts of the country. So they are basically technical in nature. If there are any questions, I will be glad to answer them. Otherwise, I do move the adoption of the Committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Mr. President. I just wanted to add that I have agreed wholeheartedly with the amendments proposed by the committee. I think they help the bill. I think they're very positive, and I think it makes a good bill better. If you have any questions, I'd be glad to answer them.

SENATOR KAHLE: Mr. President, the only thing...I thought we passed a bill very similar to this last year. Is this correct, or not?

SENATOR WESELY: Is that a question to me, Senator? Yes, we did and there were some problems in the manner in which these handicapped parking licenses or permits were distributed.

SENATOR KAHLE: So this is actually a clarification or addition to what we did last year?

SENATOR WESELY: Absolutely. It's a clarification and fine tuning, I think.

SENATOR KAHLE: Okay, thank you.
