SENATOR MARESH: Well, I guess if it would make a difference of being killed or being passed, I guess I would give it a chance by taking the University back out, reconsider our action on this bill. I voted to include the University. I thought probably we could get the bill passed with the University in the bill and I guess that remains to be seen. I would like to see them included myself.

SENATOR CULLAN: Okay, thank you, Senator Maresh. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I am still a little confused as to the proponents of this bill as to exactly why it is beneficial, and I would hope that those who would oppose Senator Landis' motion could explain why we should oppose his motion. I still haven't heard a great deal of discussion as to the merits of the bill and all I have heard are strong arguments that justify killing the bill and very few that justify not killing the bill, and if there are those who have good arguments, please bring them forward.

SENATOR MARSH PRESIDING

SENATOR MARSH: Thank you, Senator Cullan. Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: I have a motion there, Mr. Speaker, Madam Chairman. Will the Clerk please read the motion?

CLERK: Madam President, the motion reads as follows: To pass over LB 108 until February 20.

SENATOR MARESH: As I stated before, Senator Frank Lewis and Senator Koch have interest in this bill and I think in courtesy to these two Senators we should hold it up until Tuesday, February 20th.

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Marvel.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I think the introducer of the bill has a right to pass over it for one day. If he tries it a second time, the bill goes to the bottom of General File but I oppose any bracketing. We have set a policy and Senator Maresh is familiar with this and he has a perfect right to put the motion but I got out of the Chair for the express purpose of opposing any bracketing and to remind the Legislature once again that if we get into the business of bracketing legislation, shoving it aside, all
