There is only one Senator excused. Senator Nichol, Senator Wagner. Senator Koch is missing. Senator Lamb is missing. Senator Clark, Senator Haberman, Senator Frank Lewis. Senator Clark, Senator Lewis, Senator Haberman are still missing. Senator Clark is arriving right now. Senator Haberman is missing and Senator Frank Lewis is missing. Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: Madam President, may I request that the roll call begin with Senator Newell?

SENATOR MARSH: I believe I will rule that out of order, Senator Murphy. All right, we are ready to go.

CLERK: Read roll call vote as found on pages 563 and 564 of the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Haberman, did you cast a vote on this?

CLERK: Senator Haberman voting no. 19 ayes, 24 nays, Madam Chairman.
