We can get into that later but how in the world are you going to say in the bill itself that there must be an imminent peril to the woman in order to forego informed consent but the very definition of emergency situation which allows the physician to decide that there should be an immediate abortion without any delay, they contradict each other. They are not consistent. There need not be imminent peril to the woman's life or her health. The definition of emergency situation allows the physician as the Supreme Court indicates to make a medical judgment that the abortion should not be delayed. You are going to adopt that amendment, yet here you are in the bill itself and you don't want to strike it saying that the only time there can be the waiver of the informed consent, which means a delay occurring, is if there is imminent peril to the life. That does not make sense to me, but I guess when you have different people from different places take in a little here, take in a little there and putting it together with glue, scotch tape, baling wire, you come up with a mish mash and a hodgepodge that makes everybody go away feeling that something has really been done. We really put one over on the Legislature. Well you did. You have put something over on the people who are dumb, but you won't put anything over on me and that is why I am calling attention to these things. So all the smart Senators will read this bill and read the amendments and read Judge Urbom's decision. The dummies will not do any reading but I accept these conflicting, inconsistent, contradictory provisions and you will have what existed in Dr. Doolittle called the Pushmi, Pullyu. It was an animal that had a head at each end. In Greek mythology the god, Janus, had a face on the front of the head and the back of the head so he could look both directions at the same time. The Pushmi, Pullyu has a head at each end and feet so it can go both directions, opposite directions, at the same time. Now the Legislature is able to go in all directions at the same time and that is an inherent contradiction, so that means rather than go in all directions at the same time, you are going no direction at all. If you read these things you will see a number of problems. Now look again at the definition of abortion where a device is defined as an abortion, a device. An I.U.D. is an abortion. A morning after pill is an abortion. The pill is an abortion. Suppose a woman drank some grease or oil before she took one of these pills and her system did not absorb it.
