SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of a Call of the House vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 1 nay to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators return to their seats. All unauthorized personnel leave the chamber and record your presence. We are recording our presence prior to a roll call vote on a kill motion on 316. Senator Landis. All legislators must be in their seats. Please record your presence. Senator Hefner. Senator Kremer. Senator Dworak. Senator Cullan. Senator Haberman, will you record your presence, please? We need Senator Cullan, Senator Dworak, Senator Goodrich and Senator Frank Lewis. Others are excused. Senator Goodrich, will you record your presence? We are under Call. Senator Newell, will you record your presence? Senator Nichol, will you record your presence? Senator Chambers, I have two that are... Shall we proceed with the roll call? Okay, Clerk will proceed with the roll call.

CLERK: Read roll call vote found on pages 567-568 of the Legislative Journal. 6 ayes, 35 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to indefinitely postpone.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. The Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Move the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is that LB 316 be advanced to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote. Record vote.

CLERK: Read record vote found on page 568 of the Legislative Journal. 33 ayes, 9 nays, 4 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.
