Yes, this will require 25 votes. Have you all voted? Record the vote. Who asked for a record vote? Senator Keyes. Senator Kelly voting aye. Okay, it is a record vote then that has been requested so proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Read record vote found on pages 616-617. 28 ayes, 8 nays, 13 not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The DeCamp amendment is adopted. The Chair would at this time like to introduce some ten eighth graders to twelfth graders from Sidney, Mr. Bill Nichi, John Gantzer.
