PRESIDENT: Senator Cullan, did you wish to speak again?
Your light is still on.

SENATOR CULLAN: No, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Speaker Marvel, did you have anything at this
point?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are we ready to advance the bill?

PRESIDENT: That is where it is. That is right.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Kremer, I move that the... Do
you want to move that the bill be advanced?

SENATOR KREMER: I will be glad to do that. Senator Kelly
has a suggested amendment and I am perfectly willing to
adopt his amendment. We can do it over on Select File
so I am going to move. Now those that want further explana-
tion will have to vote no that it not be moved. I am going
to move now that we advance LB 26 to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Question.

PRESIDENT: And that will be your close? So the question
before the house then is the motion to advance LB 26 to
E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay.
Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the motion
advance.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. LB 26 is advanced to E &
Initial. Anything to read in, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, first of all, your committee on
Revenue whose chairman is Senator Carsten to whom is
referred LB 29 instructs me to report the same back to
the Legislature with the recommendation that it be in-
definitely postponed; LB 41 indefinitely postponed and
LB 263 indefinitely postponed, signed, Senator Carsten,
Chairman.

LB 85 correctly engrossed; 115 correctly engrossed; 194
