SPEAKER MARVEL: Clerk announce the vote.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 23 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. The Clerk will read...we now return to Final Reading, and we will read LB 117. All legislators should be in their seats, and unauthorized personnel leave the floor. As soon as all legislators are in their seats, we will proceed with Final Reading on 117. Senator Keyes, we're waiting for you. We're on Final Reading.

CLERK: (Read LB 117 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of the law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote may be found on Pages 629 and 630 of the Legislative Journal.) 31 ayes, 13 nays, 3 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: What was the...

CLERK: 31 ayes, 13 nays, 3 excused and not voting, 2 present.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, motion carried and the bill is passed. The next bill and final bill on Final Reading is LB 148.

CLERK: (Read LB 148 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of the law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Clerk record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote may be found on Page 630 of the Legislative Journal.) 46 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.
